## **Board of Supervisors Meeting**

Aileen Parrish, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, opened the Board of Supervisors meeting at 7:00pm. In attendance were Supervisors Brian Sachs and Bruce Yost, Secretary Carolyn Matalon, Treasurer Nette Stejskal and Planning Commission Member Bill Maslanka, Don Morgan, Les and Stephanie Town, Land Trust member Emily Dryden, and residents Mike Karasek and Amy Law.

**2006 Backhoe bids-** no bids received. The bids must be advertised again. Brian Sachs made a motion to approve advertisement again of the backhoe. Bruce Yost seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

#### **New Business**

<u>Purchase of Backhoe-</u> Costar new backhoe pricing cost \$150,000, while repairing the older Township 2006 model was over \$20,000. E Marlborough Twp. offered a well-maintained 2013 JCB 3CX backhoe with 3400 hours for \$23,500, inspected and approved by the road crew. Brian Sachs made a motion to approve the purchase. Bruce Yost seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

<u>Salt Bid Advertisement-</u>Bruce Yost made a motion to advertise salt bids for 2025/2026 season. Brian Sachs seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

<u>Proposed Park Ordinance-</u> Aileen Parrish made a motion to approve advertising a hearing for the Park Ordinance. Brian Sachs seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

<u>2026 Minimum Municipal Obligation for retirement plan</u>- The anticipated obligation for the 2026 LBT Pension Plan is estimated to be \$11,980.
